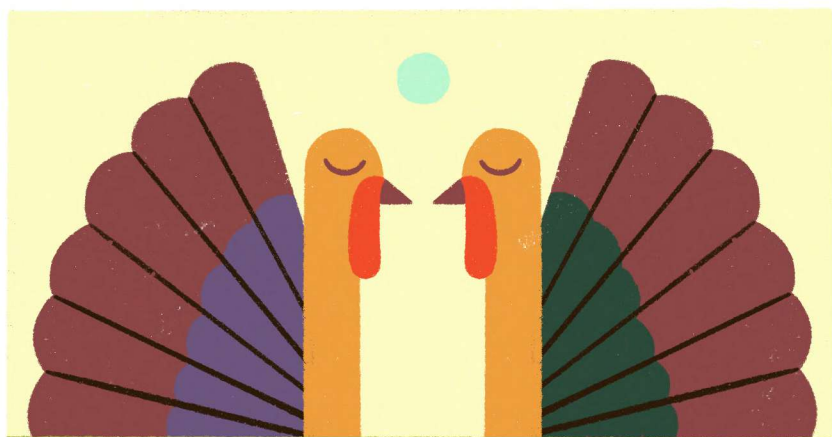

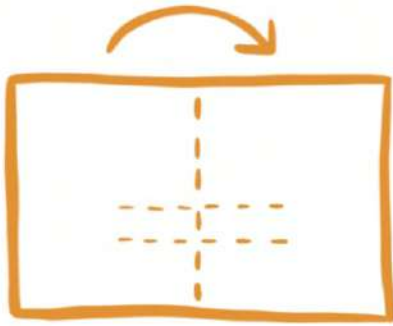

POP-UP PIE CARD



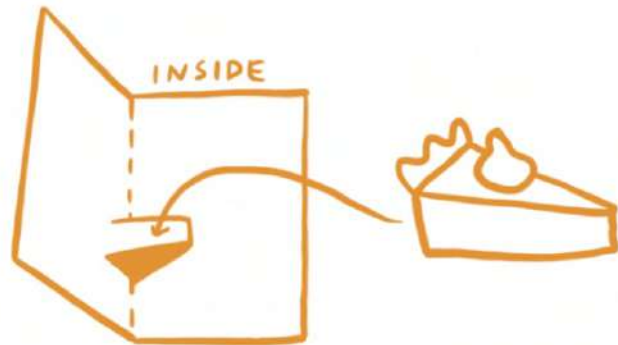
Cut out and fold

of the card.



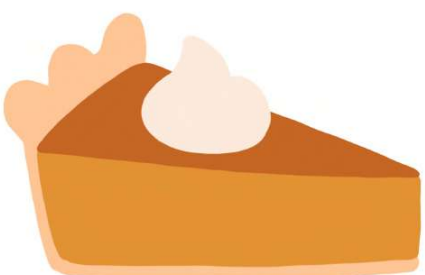
Cut out and fold in half

will hide the cut out slit.

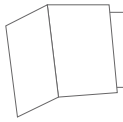

Turkey Pop-Up Card



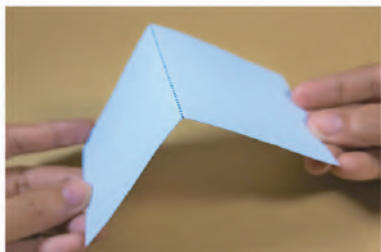
Carefully cut out the pop-up pieces for the turkey pop-up card following the solid lines with scissor icons. Score and fold according to the guide on the template.

* Type of paper to use when printing : Cardstock or paper with thickness of 120gsm to 200gsm



MOUNTAIN FOLD

The crease/fold is at the top or towards you and the paper is folded behind into itself. The paper should form a mountain when you



VALLEY FOLD

The crease/fold is at the bottom or away from you and the paper is folded forward into itself. The paper should form a "V" when you



SCORE

Paper score is a ridge that is indented into the paper where the fold line will occur. Use a empty ballpoint pen ruler or any dull edge that won't cut the paper. Press the ruler (or any dull edge used) down firmly at the place you want to fold.

Printable Thanksgiving Place Cards



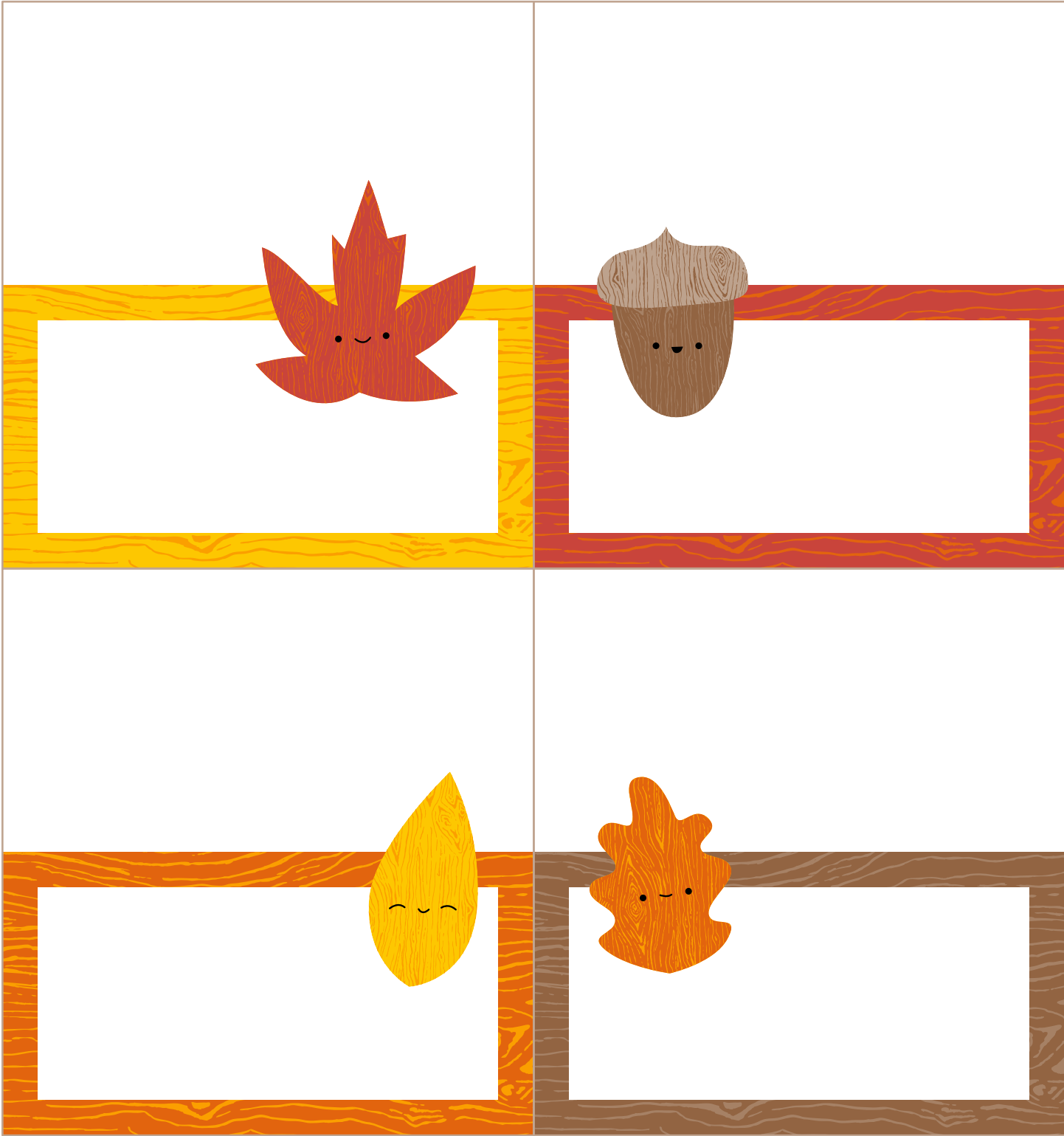
Step 1. Print the place cards on cardstock and cut them out.



Step 2. Use a craft knife to cut around the top of the leaves and acorns. Use the knife to lightly score along the center folding line at the top of the place card border.



Step 3. Fold the cards in half and then write each person's name on a place card.

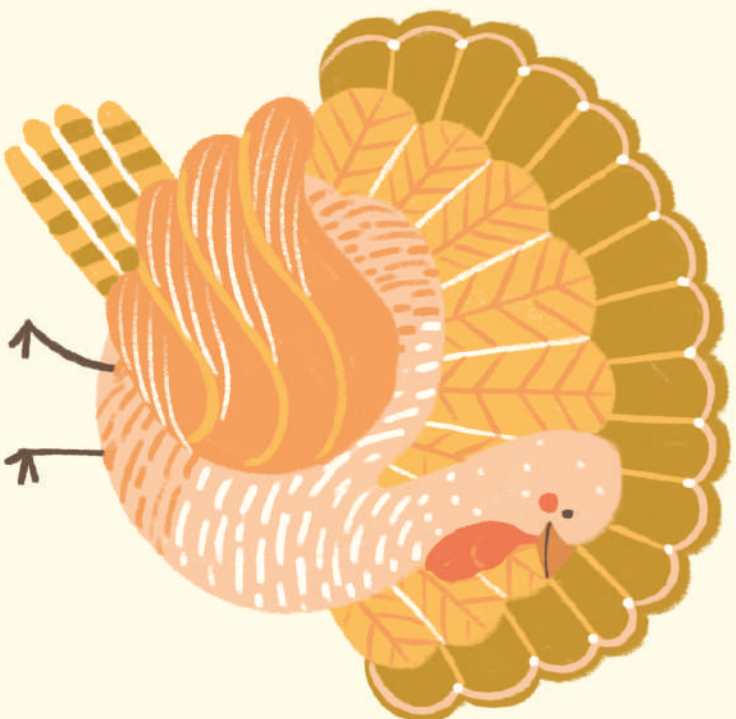

1. START WITH THE DESIGN SIDE DOWN. FOLLOW THE BLACK LINES AS FOLD GUIDELINES. FOLD IN HALF TO MAKE A LARGE TRIANGLE. OPEN UP AND REPEAT ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE (SHOULD HAVE AN X ALONG THE BACK).

2. FOLD THE 4 CORNERS INTO THE CENTER POINT.

3. FLIP OVER AND FOLD THE 4 CORNERS INTO THE CENTER POINT AGAIN.

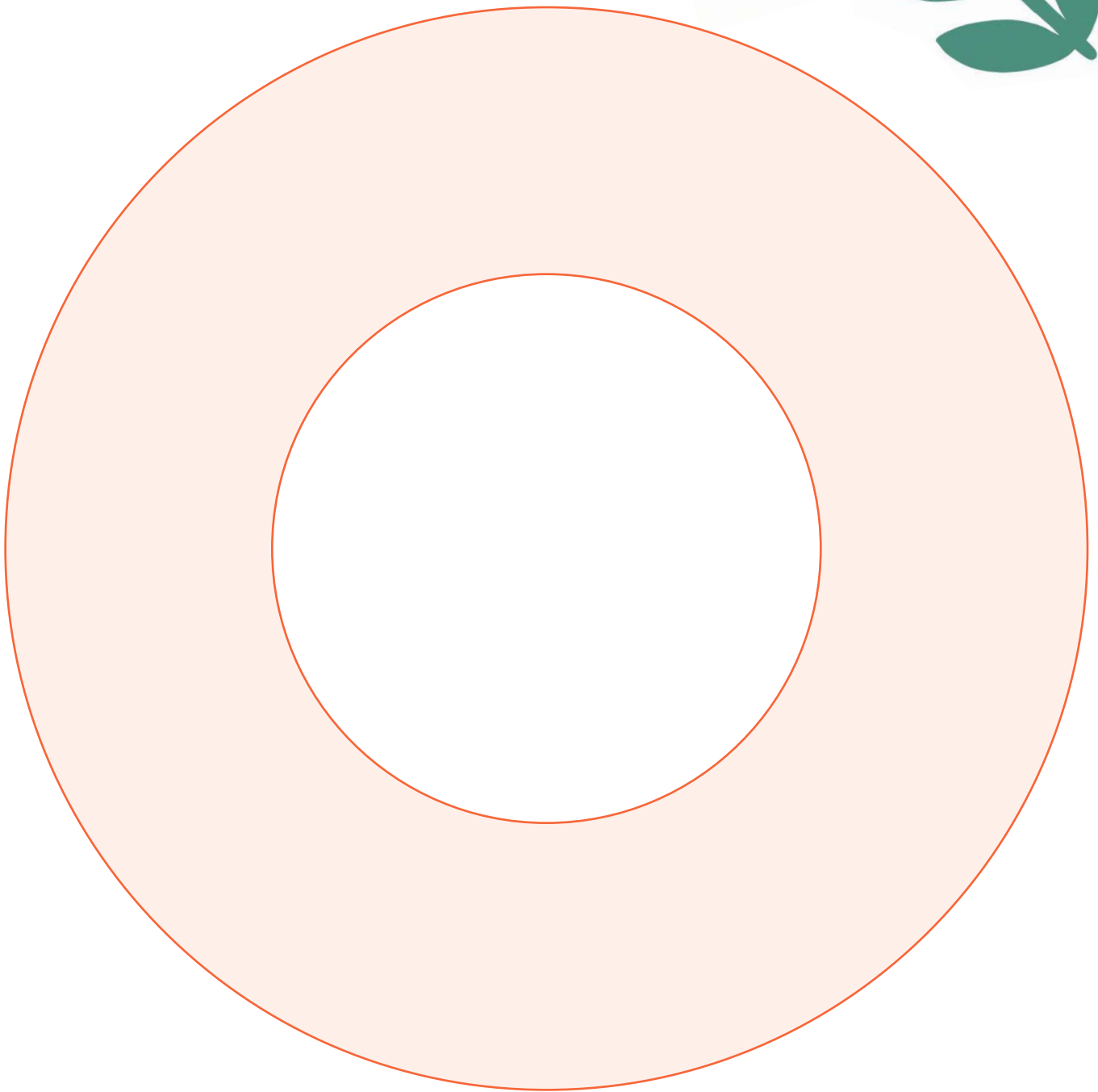
