# Philately : Postal history of India



Read the paragraph about the postal history of India and answer the questions below.

Britishers started the postal system for the purpose of commercial services for East India Company. But then, Warren Hastings (Governor General of British India from 1773-1784) opened this service to the public in March 1774. The first postal system in India was introduced on 1 July 1852 in the Scinde district. The first pictorial stamps were issued in 1931. The Postal Index Number (PIN code) is a six-digit, Unique code of the post office numbering introduced on 15 August, 1972 by Shriram Bhikaji Velankar. The First Stamp of Independent India was issued on 21 November 1947. It depicts the Indian Flag with the patriots' slogan, Jai Hind (Long Live India), on the top right hand corner. It was valued at three and one-half annas.
