Everyone in Egypt was happy they were saved from the evil king. And so were Bheem and his friends.

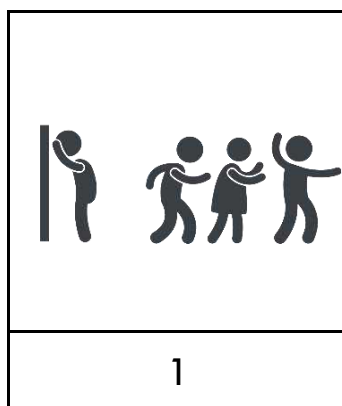
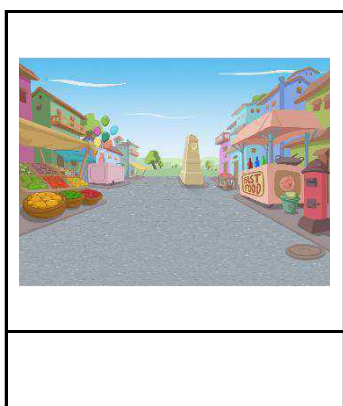
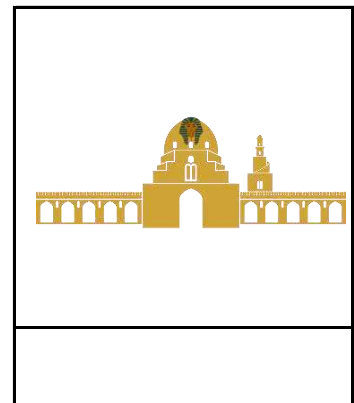
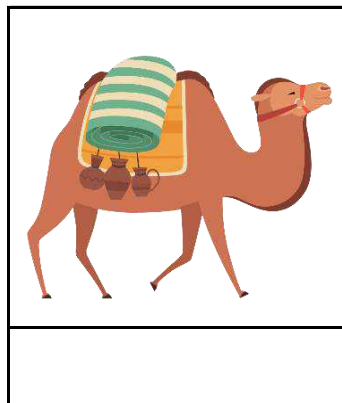
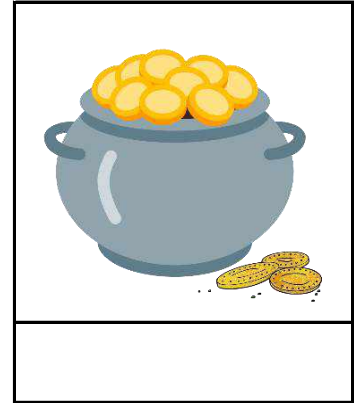
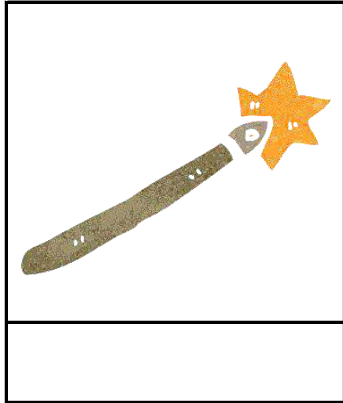




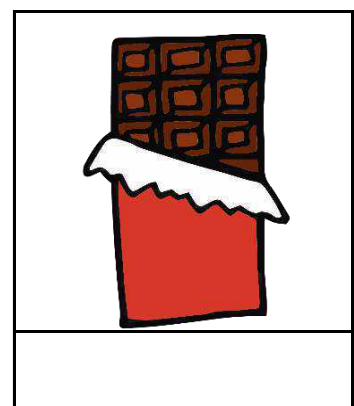
