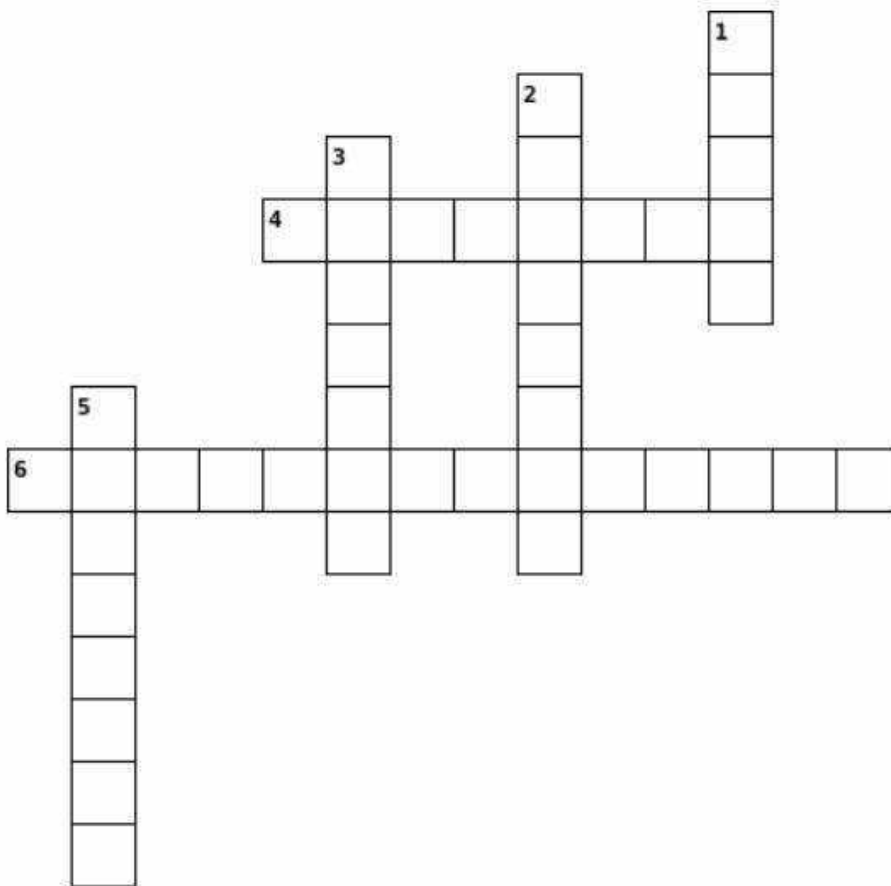

Poetry: Elements of poetry



Focussing on "elements" of poetry we can improve our understanding of a particular poem or group of poems. These elements may include, imagery, figures of speech, symbolism, sound, rhythm and meter, etc.
