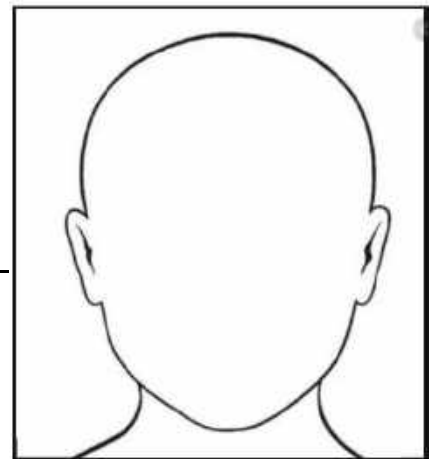


Imagine you have gone to a mime show. Fill in the facial expression by the actor in the below given images and write the expression given.
