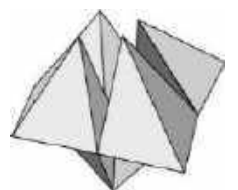
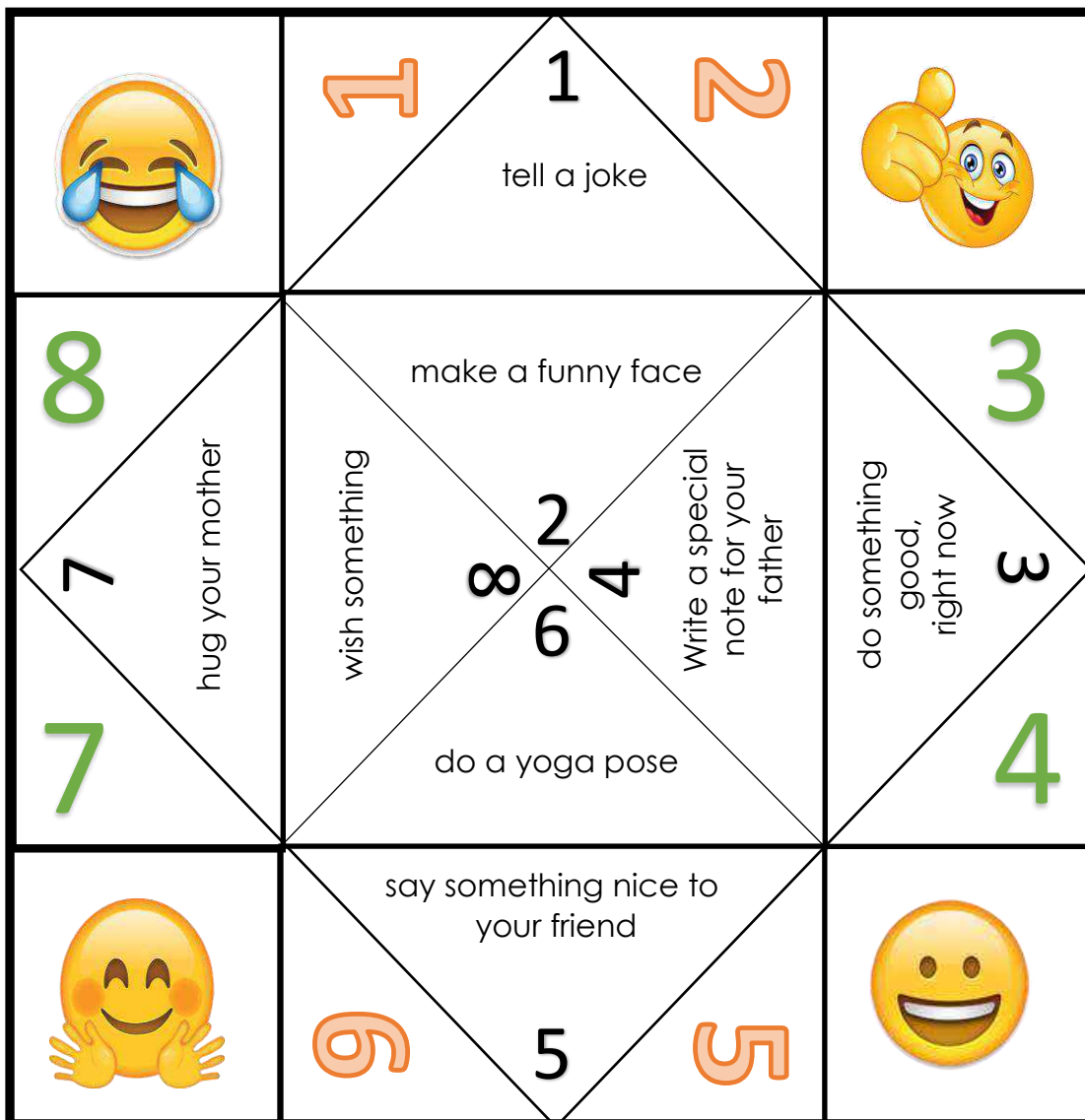
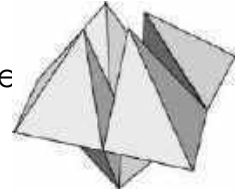


Cootie catcher
