Cut out the shapes given below along the dotted lines and make a house.



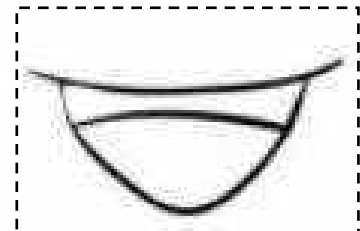
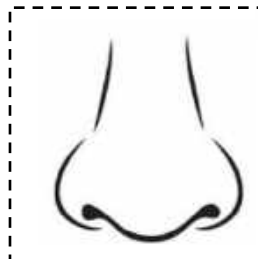
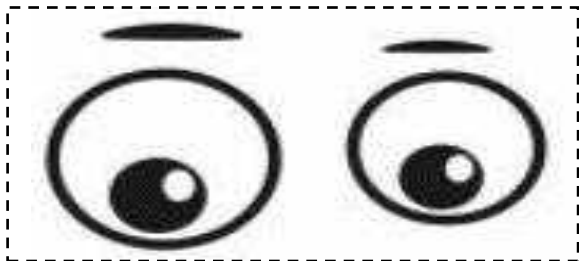
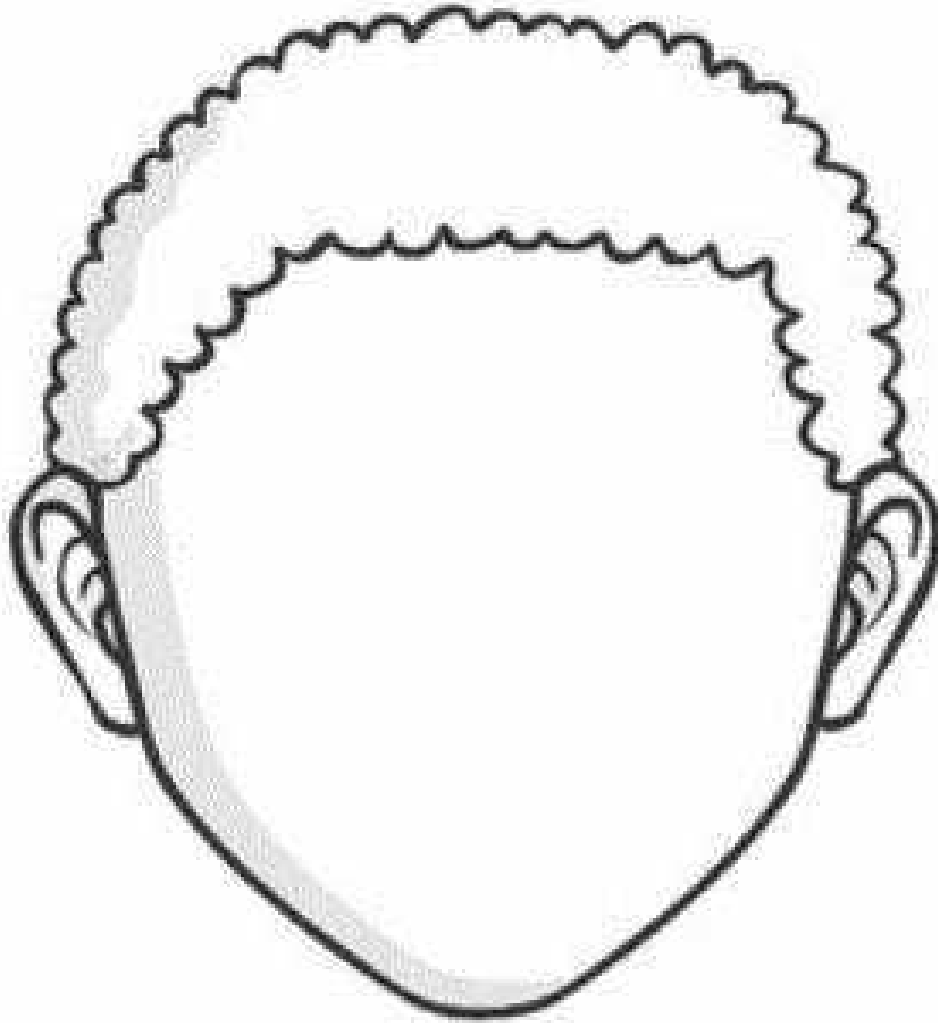

Cut out the given parts along the dotted lines and stick it on the given face template.



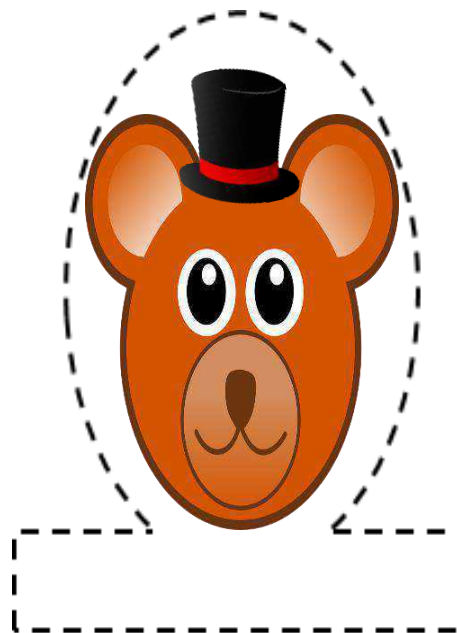
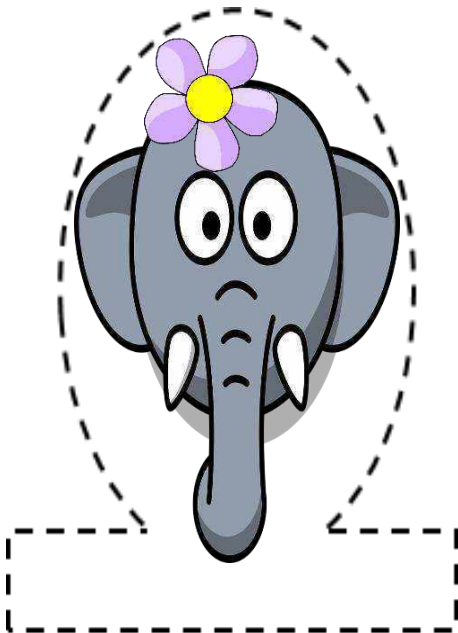
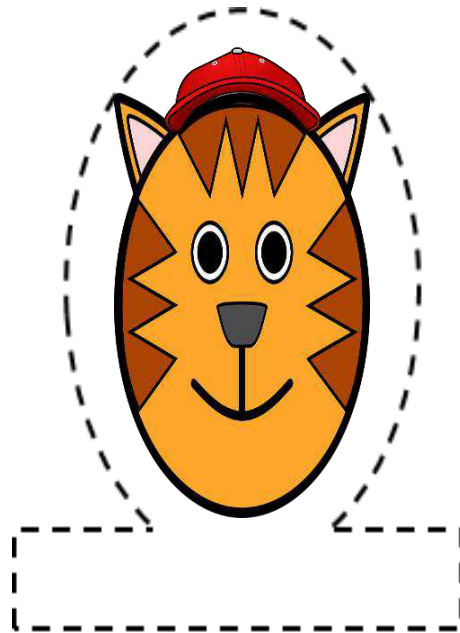
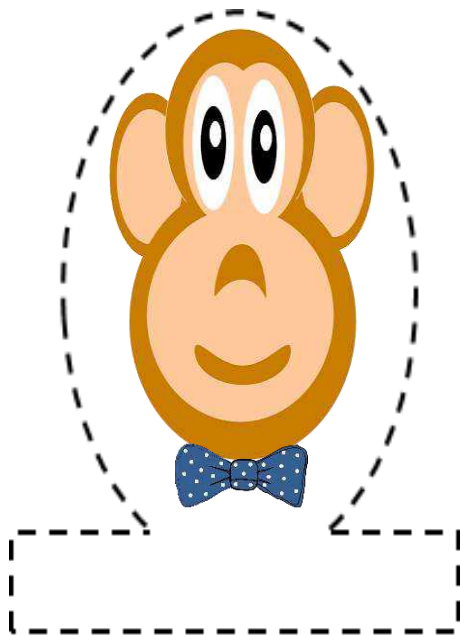
