- f. I am situated on the south eastern side of the city of Zurich. I am fed by the Linth river which rises higher up in the glacier of the Glarus Alps.



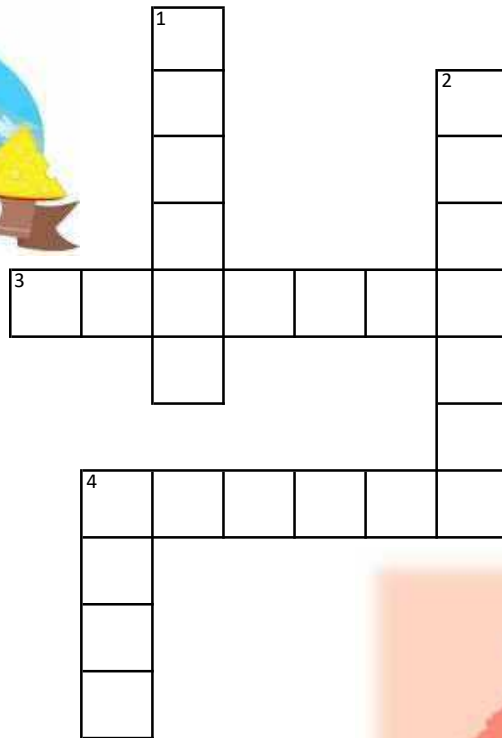
